THE SECOND ANNUAL SPRING SYMPOSIUM IS ON APRIL 12-13, 2018. THERE WILL BE NUMEROUS INDUSTRY EXPERTS SPEAKING ON THE TOPIC OF "E-COMMERCE AND ITS IMPACT ON SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT COMPETITIVENESS".



The Fall Forum that was held on November 9 and 10 in 2017 brought in over 110 attendees to lacocca Hall, at Lehigh University, overlooking the Bethlehem fall foliage. The theme was "Real World Supply Chain Solutions for Long Term Competitive Advantage." Registrants listened to keynote presentations illustrating innovative solutions to supply chain issues, and participated in interactive workshops enabling participants to learn from each other and academic and industry experts.

After the success of the Fall Forum, Lehigh CSCR is now preparing for the Spring Symposium that will take place April 12 and 13, 2018 with the theme of **E-Commerce and Its Impact on Supply Management Competitiveness**. Keynote speakers include Ed Feitzinger, Vice President of Amazon Global Logistics, Dario Martino from Johnson and Johnson, and many more, who will speak about the effect of E-Commerce on the supply chain of their companies, and new methods to control this major change in the industry.

This Spring Symposium begins with a reception at 6:00 PM on Thursday, April 12 and a whole day event on Friday, April 13. The reception on April 12 will include networking with supply chain industry professionals from various companies as well as the opportunity to meet Lehigh Supply Chain Graduate and Undergraduate students. On April 13, the registration and Continental Breakfast will open at 7:00 AM and our symposium will begin at 8:00 AM. There will be eight speaker sessions from a wide range of companies, as well as breakout sessions for individuals to meet and connect with other professionals, and learn about their most recent supply chain tactics.
