By providing a better understanding of value chains, logistic systems, demand and supply chain planning processes, operations and quality systems, and supply networks, the Supply Chain Management Certificate at Lehigh University enables participants to create competitive advantages for their organizations.

Participants in this program will:

- Understand how to model the effects of supply chain decisions and actions on a firm's financial performance
- Develop the key attributes of a lean organization and achieve competitive advantage
- Understand value creation for the customer through streamlined supply chain practices
- Link strategic planning requirements with emerging perspectives from suppliers to final customers while incorporating operations requirements over all planning horizons
- Learn to manipulate the tools and methods of strategic sourcing process such as categorizing spend, analyzing supplier markets, developing supplier strategy, and total cost of ownership
- Gain a solid understanding of leading edge tactics, techniques, and best practices
- Learn techniques for efficient transportation management control through an extended supply chain perspective

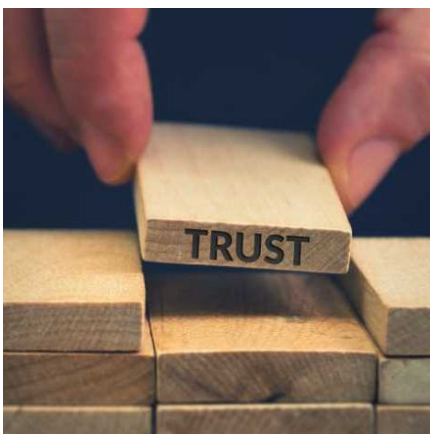
