During his tenure he led numerous complex acquisitions totaling over \$400M in capital, which consolidated a highly fragmented industry. This transaction activity included working with bankers, lawyers, accountants and outside approval agencies such as the US Justice Department, the UK Office of Fair Trade and the UK Competition Commission. Steve also participated in the company's capital restricting of two public debt offerings of \$105M and \$785M in 2002 and 2010 respectively. In 2014, Steve led the sale of GXS to OpenText (NASDAQ:OTEX) for \$1.2B. After the sale of GXS in 2014, Steve moved to DiCentral were he currently works today.
